**BREED SHOW – OPEN CLASSES AND CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES**

**Young Horse/Sport Horse Classes – Open Show**

Class 1: Fillies of 2009, with or without dam, foals only to be judged

Class 2: Yearling Fillies (born in 2008)

Class 3: Two Year old Fillies (born in 2007)

Class 4: Three Year old Fillies (born in 2006)

Class 5: **Filly Champion of Open Show / Great American / USDFBC Qualifier** – 1<sup>st</sup> two places from classes 1, 2, 3, 4 (no class fee)

Class 6: Colts of 2009, with or without dam, foals only to be judged

Class 7: Yearling Colts and Geldings (born in 2008)

Class 8: Two Year old Colts and Geldings (born in 2007)

Class 9: Three Year Old Colts and Geldings (born in 2006)

Class 10: **Colt Champion of Open Show / Great American / USDFBC Qualifier** – 1<sup>st</sup> two places from classes 6, 7, 8, 9 (no class fee)

Class 11: **Young Horse Champion of Open Show** – 1<sup>st</sup> two places from classes 5, 10 (no class fee)

### **Mature Horse/Breeding Classes – Open Show**

Class 12: Four Year Old and Older Broodmares with or without foals (mares only to be judged)

Class 13: Four Year Old and Older Maiden and Yeld Mares (not nursing or currently in foal)

Class 14: **Champion Mare of Open Show / Great American / USDFBC Qualifier** – 1<sup>st</sup> two places from classes 12, 13 (no class fee)

Class 15: Four Year Old and Older Stallions

Class 16: **Champion Stallion of Open Show / Great American / USDFBC Qualifier** – 1<sup>st</sup> two places from class 15 (no class fee)

Class 17: **Mature Horse Champion of Open Show** – 1<sup>st</sup> two places from classes 14, 16 (no class fee)

Class 18: **Grand Champion of Open Show** – 1<sup>st</sup> two places from classes 11, 17 (no class fee)

### **Great American / USDF Breeders' Championship – Rocky Mountain Breeder's Championship 2009**

Class 19: USDFBC Filly Finals – open to all Champion and Reserve Fillies from qualifying series eligible to compete (class fee for this class)

Class 20: USDFBC Colt/Gelding Final – open to all Champion and Reserve Colts/Geldings from qualifying series eligible to compete (class fee for this class)

Class 21: USDFBC Mare Finals – open to all Champion and Reserve Mares from qualifying series eligible to compete (class fee for this class)

Class 22: USDFBC Stallion Finals – open to all Champion and Reserve Stallions from qualifying series eligible to compete (class fee for this class)

### **RMDS Sport Horse Breeding Championship – 2009**

All qualified horses will be run individually on the triangle in classes 23 and 24. Scores from Championship Classes will not count in the RMDS Awards Program. Scores from the open show classes will count.

**Class 23: RMDS Championship - Young Horse Champion**

(only open to those horses that have qualified previously or at this Open Show, class fee for this class)

**Class 24: RMDS Championship - Mature Horse Champion**

(only open to those horses that have qualified previously or at this Open Show, class fee for this class)

**Class 25: RMDS Championship – Grand Champion Horse**

Highest score of the 1<sup>st</sup> two places of classes 23 and 24 (no class fee)

**Under Saddle Classes – Open Show – Only one horse can be ridden per class by an individual rider.**

Class 26: Three Year Old Fillies Materiale

Class 27: Three Year Old Colts and Geldings Materiale

Class 28: Four and Five Year Old Mares Materiale

Class 29: Four and Five Year Old Stallions Materiale

Class 30: Suitable to Become a Dressage Horse – Open to horses any sex, six years and under, not competing above First Level

**Class 31: Champion Under Saddle of Open Show** – 1<sup>st</sup> two places from classes 26, 27, 28, 29, 30 (no class fee)

**QUALIFYING FOR BREED CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES**

NOTE: The open breed show is a qualifier for the Great American / USDF Breeders' Championships – Rocky Mountain Series Final as well as for the RMDS Sporthorse Breeding Championship 2009.

To qualify for the Great American / USDF Breeders' Championships – Rocky Mountain Series Final: Horses that have been Champion or Reserve Champion Filly, Gelding, Mare or Stallion at any qualifying show (including this Open Show) are automatically qualified to enter the Great American / USDF Breeder's Championships. See the current RMDS Omnibus for a list of qualifying shows for this year.

To qualify for RMDS Sporthorse Breeding Championships: the first and second place horse from any RMDS recognized sporthorse breeding class (including this Open Show) is eligible to attend the RMDS Sporthorse Breeding Championships in that class. The horse, owner and handler must be RMDS members in good standing at the time the placing was earned.

All horses entered in any Great American / USDF Breeders' Championship Series show must either be registered with USDF or pay a \$20.00 USDF Horse Identification Number Fee (that is good for the life of the horse but not eligible for any USDF Year End Awards), and submit identification information and (if available) a copy of the registry papers directly to USDF or to the first Great American / USDFBC Qualifying Event that they enter. Any horse participating in the Series Final classes must be lifetime registered with USDF. The DSHB Identification Number Fee will apply toward the (lifetime) USDF Horse Registration Fee. Awards may be withheld by USDF to Series winners if the following information, if known, is not provided to USDF or show management prior to reporting or competition deadlines: name and breed of horse, sire, dam, dam's sire, age, sex, breeder, handler and owner.

**Breed Show Fees:**

- Breed show open classes **\$35** per class – all classes except call back classes 5, 10, 11, 14, 16, 17, 18, 25, 31.
- RMDS Championship Breed Classes 23, 24 - **\$40** per class.
- RMDS Grand Champion Class #25 – **no fee**
- Great American / USDF Breeders' Champ classes 19, 20, 21, 22 - **\$40** per class.
- Office fee **\$40** per breed show entry
- All **USEF/USDF fees are applicable**. Refund policy and stabling fees are stated in the RMDS Championships prize list.

**Awards:**

- Ribbons to 6<sup>th</sup> place for the open show classes, champion and reserve champion ribbons for call back classes.
- Open Show classes – 1<sup>st</sup> place trophies.
- RMDS Sport Horse Breeding Championships neck ribbon to champion and reserve champion, trophy for champion, bridle ribbons 3<sup>rd</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> place.
- Great American / USDF Breeders' Series Champions receive a Champion neck sash, embroidered cooler, and plaque. Reserve champions receive a reserve neck sash and plaque.
